«International Rendezvous»

Teams

- Each team shall consist of three archers.
- All team members must be participants in the hosting Rendezvous. They will qualify for inclusion in their national team in order of their placement in the hosting Rendezvous.
- Each team must include at least one lady and/or junior archer.
- Both longbow/selfbow and recurves must be represented.
- Composite/Second teams: Where insufficient representatives of a nationality are present to form a team then a composite team may be formed but cannot win the trophy. A second national team may also be entered at the discretion of the hosting Rendezvous. This team would not be eligible to win the trophy.
- Each team will nominate a team leader.

Equipment

- Rules applying to the host Rendezvous competition will apply.
- Archers shall use the same equipment used in preceding Rendezvous.

Competition

- The competition will consist of three different activities. The activities will be determined by the hosting Rendezvous and details will not be disclosed until the commencement of the competition.
- The winning team will be that team with the highest number of points accumulated by all the team members over the three activities.
- At stake will be the Pacific Bowhunters Trophy. The winners will hold the trophy for one year and their «team leader» is responsible for the return of the trophy to the next annual International Rendezvous.
